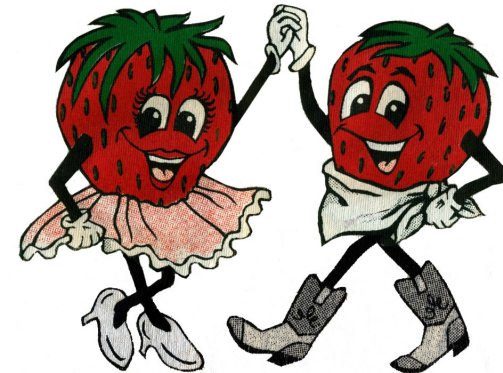

Lebanon Square Circlers

Lebanon Square Circlers have been dancing since 1949 and is the second oldest square dance club in Oregon. The club started after the American Legion Auxiliary sponsored lessons, and has been running continuously ever since. Located in Lebanon, Oregon, heart of the Willamette Valley, the club insignia is the strawberry. Celebrating the Lebanon Strawberry Festival every year, the club joins in the festivities by participating in the Strawberry parade and sponsoring dances and activities during the first full weekend in June. Dances are held every first and third Saturday night (September—June) at the Lebanon Senior Center, 80 Tangent Street, with Pre-Rounds starting at 7:30pm, Mainstream at 8:00pm and Plus at 10:15pm. The club welcomes couples, singles and family groups. Lessons begin every September and the club welcomes any interested individuals and especially families. Dances are \$7.00 and lessons are \$6.00 (except for the Birthday and Strawberry Festival ALLIANCE Dances). Family rate is \$15.00 (2 adults and all children under age 18). Door Duty

- If you can come early, please do so to arrange tables and chairs in the refreshment area. (Tables need to be folded and rolled, not slid.)
- Set up Cashier's Table (white table on stage) and put strawberry tablecloth on.
- Meet Treasurer (or representative) at 7:15pm to accept money box and count out \$75.
- Primary Door Person: Accept dance fees and make sure each dancer signs Attendance Sheet.
- Secondary Door Person: Accept Split the Pot fees (3 tickets for \$1.00) and separate tickets; give one half to the dancer and put the other half in the Split the Pot.
- Write receipts and attach sticky notes as needed for other money received (dues, etc.).
- Around 8:15pm, total dancers by Club and give tally to President. Count and total money and return money box to Treasurer - go dance!
- **Help with Clean-Up Duty.**

Kitchen Duty

- If you can come early, please do so to arrange tables and chairs in the refreshment area. (Tables need to be folded and rolled, not slid.)
- Put out strawberry tablecloths on serving tables and cashier's table.
- Bring crates out of the LSC cabinet and set out plates, napkins, cups, etc.
- Make one pot of regular coffee, and one pot of decaf (4 scoops each).
- Make sure creamer, sugar and stir sticks are set out.
- Set out marker pens with the coffee for people to label their cups.
- Set out hand sanitizer.
- Put out serving utensils as needed.
- Wash club members' dishes and take to front of hall with any leftover food at end of dance.
- **Help with Clean-Up Duty.**

Lessons

Square dance and round dance lessons begin every September and the club welcomes any interested individuals. Lessons usually run 3-1/2 to 4 months.

You do not have to have a partner to square dance! Solo dancers and families welcome!

Club Outfits

Square Dance Etiquette

Square dance clubs need club member support in order to operate - you do this by:

- Attending all club dances possible.
- Bringing finger-foods to every club dance.
- Attending club visitations.
- Attending club meetings and social activities.
- Helping out with decorations for special dances and helping with other special projects.
- Signing up for Dance Duty at least once a year (remember-YOU are responsible for finding a replacement if you can't make it).
- Paying dues in a timely manner.
- Helping "Angel" new dancers at lessons.
- Taking a turn as an officer.
- Attending special "ALLIANCE" events.

The "ALLIANCE"

The ALLIANCE consists of four clubs that support each other: Corvallis Squares, Albany Timber Twirlers, Lebanon Square Circlers and Sweet Home Squarenaders. The ALLIANCE sponsors a Plus Dance every second Friday, held at the Albany IOOF Hall, as well as designates certain Mainstream Dances at the various clubs as special "ALLIANCE Dances," including Birthday Dances. All members of the ALLIANCE clubs are *strongly* encouraged to support the ALLIANCE Special Dances.

Keeper of the Keys

- Arrive half an hour early to unlock front door.
- Turn on lights.
- Unlock back door and assist caller/cuer with equipment.
- Unlock LSC storage cabinet.
- Bring Sandwich sign down from stage and display out front near the parking lot, visible from the street.

End of Dance:

- Lock storage cabinet and turn off backstage light.
- Inspect hall, kitchen area and restrooms.
- Lock and secure front and back doors (make sure they are shut tight).
- Set the alarm.
- Turn off lights.

Clean-Up Duty

- Wipe all dining area tables (towels are found in the LSC cabinet).
- Put tables and chairs away **after** the caller leads the final Thank You. (Tables need to be folded and rolled, not slid.)
- Return white Cashier's Table to storage spot at back of stage.
- Wipe dry sinks in bathroom and kitchen area (leave garbage for Janitor unless overflowing).
- Take home used towels to wash and bring to the next dance.
- Dust mop dance floor. Rub out black marks.
- Make sure someone brings the Sandwich Board Sign in.
- Return crates to the LSC cabinet.
- Take kitchen garbage home *only* if the can is full (and replace garbage bag).
- Wipe down and roll up strawberry tablecloths (make sure they are dry).
- All items used should be put back where you found them — *Clean and dry.*
